

## **Notice of Collection of Personal Information**

The personal information that you submit in Nova is collected under the authority of the Arts Council Act and will be used for the following purposes:

- To create and provide you with access to your profile and protected content;
- To create a unique contact identification number linked to your application history, to your role with OAC and contact information;
- To contact you regarding your application, nomination or request;
- To administer the grant application or award nomination;
- To determine an applicant's eligibility and for consideration during the assessment process of grant and award applications;
- To consider you as a potential assessor;
- To administer your role as an assessor or recommender;
- To consult with other Canadian arts funders, including federal, provincial or municipal government institutions to confirm funding sources, or to disclose where OAC has a partnership program and the disclosure is consistent with that program's guidelines;
- To perform business, technical or professional activities in fulfillment of OAC's mandate;
- To plan, evaluate and review OAC programs, and for generating statistics for statistical reporting, studies, issue and trend analysis;
- To send OAC publications, surveys and other information relevant to the arts community;
- To publish grant and award results by program and deadline, including recipients' and assessors' names and locations (i.e. city/town/First Nation) and grant amounts, on the OAC website, in the OAC Grants Listing and through other OAC communications.
